ITINERARY DETAILS OF PUTHA HIUNCHULI EXPEDITION (7246M/ 23772FT)

Day 01	19 Sept	Arrival at Kathmandu airport and transfer to a hotel in Kathmandu (1350m/ 4,430ft).
Day 02	20 Sept	Preparation, briefings at the Department of Tourism, last-minute shopping and office formalities.
Day 03	21 Sept	After breakfast, flight from Kathmandu to Nepalgunj; hotel accommodation. (Takes about 45 minutes)
Day 04	22 Sept	Flight from Nepalgunj to Juphal (Dolpo), then trek to Dunai(2230m/7316ft.)-03hrs; lodge accommodation.
Day 05	23 Sept	Trek from Dunai to Tarakot(2680m/8793ft.) -06hrs camping accommodation .

Day 06	24 Sept	Trek from Tarakot to Musikhola (2800m/ 986ft)-06hrs; camping accommodation.
Day 07	25 Sept	Trek from Musikhol to Kakkotgoan (3295m/ 10810ft.) - 05hrs; lodge accommodation or camping.
Day 08	26 Sept	Trek from Kakkotgoan to Yak Kharka (3960m/12992ft.) - 06hrs; camping accommodation.
Day 09	27 Sept	Trek from Yak Kharka to Putha Phedi (4430m/14534ft.) - 06hrs; camping accommodation.
Day 10	28 Sept	Trek from Putha Phedi to Putha Hiunchuli Base camp (4800m/15748ft) -06hrs; camping accommodation.
Day11-23	29Sep-11Oct	Climbing period and summit to Putha Hiunchuli (7246m/ 23773ft).
Day 24	12 Oct	Trek from Putha Hinchuli Base Camp to Kakkotgoan (3295m/ 10810ft.)-05hrs; lodge accommodation or camping.
Day 25	13 Oct	Trek from Kakkotgoan to Laisi camp (2800m/ 986ft) - 06hrs; camping accommodation.
Day 26	14 Oct	Trek from Laisi Camp to Mushi Khola (2800m/ 986ft) - 06hrs; camping accommodation.
Day 27	15 Oct	Trek from Musikhola to Dunai (2230m/ 7316ft.) - 03hrs; camping accommodation.
Day 28	16 Oct	Trek from Duani to Juphal and prepare for the next day's flight to Nepalgunj. Overnight at the lodge accommodation.
Day: 29	17 Oct	Fly from Juphal to Nepalgunj and a connecting flight to Kathmandu. Overnight at hotel.
Day 30	18 Oct	Free and rest day at Kathmandu. A farewell celebration dinner with a cultural program will be held in the evening.
Day 31	19 Oct	Transfer to Kathmandu airport for final departure.

FULL BOARD SERVICE COST INCLUDES

- All arrival and departure transfer services to and from KTM International Airport, with other necessary transportation as per the itinerary.
- Assistance at KTM International Airport by Satori Adventures representatives during your arrival and departure.
- 4-night 3-4 star hotel accommodation in Kathmandu on a bed and breakfast (B&B) basis.
- Experienced and government-licensed trekking and climbing Sherpa guide during the trekking and climbing period.
- An appropriate number of porters during the trekking period.
- Kathmandu - Nepalgunj - Juphal - Kathmandu flight transportation for all climbing members, Sherpa guide, liaison officer.
- Kathmandu- Nepalgunj - Juphal bus transportation for kitchen staff.
- Kathmandu- Nepalgunj - Juphal bus transportation for Nepal staff and cargo.
- All Satori Adventures facilities include: a kitchen tent, storage tent, dining tent, client tents, toilet tents, tables, chairs, and cooking utensils for base camp.
- Common climbing equipment includes: rope, ice bars, ice screws, and snow bars.
- 3 meals a day: breakfast, lunch, and dinner, with tea or coffee.
- Accommodation at a hotel/ lodge/ guest house, or tent camps during trekking.
- All camping accommodations for members and staff during the trekking and climbing period. You will be sharing sleeping quarters with one other member.
- All food and fuel for base camp and higher camps during the climbing period.

FULL BOARD SERVICE COST INCLUDES



- A 40kg baggage allowance is available per person during the trekking period. Porters or mules will carry this.
- Daily weather report services from a Seattle, Washington - based company.
- Services of a chef and a kitchen assistant at an advanced base camp.
- Trekking Permit (Annapurna Conservation Park entry fee).
- TIMS card (Trekking Information Management System).
- Expedition Royalty and a permit from the Nepal government to climb Mt. Putha Hiunchuli Peak.
- Nepalese government royalty.
- One experienced, trained, government-licensed, and two-time summiteer climbing guide (Sherpa) per person.
- All wages, equipment, medical and accident insurance for all involved staff during the trekking and climbing period.
- Helicopter rescue insurance for all expedition staff involved.
- Medical consultation services are available at the base camp through the HRA clinic.
- Equipment allowances and wages for climbing Sherpas, cooks, kitchen assistants and government liaison officers.
- First aid medical kits for the group and the staff.
- The guide for communication carries a satellite phone. Available to clients at a cost of USD 33 per minute.
- Provide appropriate high-altitude food for all clients and staff at base camp and above as required.
- Required fixed and dynamic rope during the climbing period.
- Heater will be provided at the base camp for the dining tent.
- Emergency oxygen mask and regulator provided upon request by the client, subject to an appropriate charge.
- Each client will have an individual tent available in the Putha Hiunchuli advanced base camp.
- Solar panels for lighting and charging electronic devices.
- All tents for camps I, II and III. Icefall charges.



FULL BOARD SERVICE COST INCLUDES

- Gamow Bags (Portable hyperbaric chambers) for high altitude sickness.
- We provide Sherpa's tents, food for climbing and insurance.
- Free assistance service for cargo clearance and duties.
- EPI cooking gas and stove will be provided above the base camp for cooking food.
- The generator will provide backup for the lighting at the base camp.
- Transportation of food supply from Kathmandu to base camp by porters/ mules.
- Our service charge and government taxes are levied in Nepal.
- Complete pre-departure information.
- Flight ticket reconfirmation and visa extension procedure services.
- Farewell dinner in a typical Nepali restaurant with a cultural show in Kathmandu before departure.
- Satori Adventures t-shirt and scarf.

FULL BOARD SERVICE COST EXCLUDES

- Lunch and dinner during your stay in Kathmandu (except for the farewell dinner).
- Any packed food/ snacks, aerated drinks, energy drinks, mineral water, alcohol, cigarettes, chocolates, or any other food consumed beyond the prescribed breakfast, lunch and dinner.
- Expenses incurred for the use of landlines, mobile phones, walkie-talkies, satellite phones, and the internet.
- Clothing, packing items or bags, a personal medical kit, and personal trekking gear.
- Any extra expenses arising out of various/ unforeseen situations like natural calamities, landslides, political disturbances, strikes, changes in government regulations, etc.
- Transportation services include only what is listed on the itinerary. Any additional distance travelled will be charged accordingly.

- Summit bonus USD 800.00 minimum for each climbing Sherpa guide.
- Nepal's customs duty for importing expedition equipment.
